The House of God Church Addresses West Hollywood Property Matter and Reaffirms Commitment to Transparency and Unity

The House of God Church – Keith Dominion issues the following statement regarding recent public claims related to the West Hollywood property and surrounding circumstances.

The Church extends continued prayers and sincere concern for all members connected to the West Hollywood congregation during this time. Leadership remains hopeful that all parties will come to a full and accurate understanding of the facts.

The organization affirms that recent public narratives have been shaped, in part, by incomplete or inaccurate representations of the situation. Trust remains a foundational value of the House of God Church, and its preservation is of the utmost importance.

The Church further notes that ongoing legal actions, based on claims of local ownership, are inconsistent with the documented governance and ownership structure of the organization and have resulted in significant legal expense.

Beginning in 2020, the national church invested more than \$100,000 into the West Hollywood church while providing extended time, guidance, and support to local leadership to strengthen attendance and improve financial stability. As recently as the beginning of 2025 multiple meetings were conducted over several months with direct involvement from national leadership. Despite these efforts, the challenges were not resolved.

It is also noteworthy that the individual associated with the initial legal filing (October 1, 2025) admittedly encouraged the sale of the West Hollywood property and participated in preparing the facility for sale. Subsequent public statements describing the sale as unexpected are inconsistent with that prior involvement.

The Church emphasizes that no members have been displaced. All members formerly attending the West Hollywood Church were invited to continue fellowship at other established House of God locations within 30 minutes or to participate in helping to establish the new House of God Church of South Florida in Pompano Beach. Transportation assistance, including door-to-door

options, was offered following months of engagement beginning in early 2025, including in-person gatherings held March 22 and May 30, 2025.

In September 2025, the Chief Overseer initiated a formal review of the matter. Following multiple presentations and extended deliberation, members of the Supreme Executive Council and General Trustee Board unanimously approved proceeding with the sale on September 19, 2025. The Chief Overseer accepted their recommendation.

The House of God Church remains committed to reconciliation, restoration, and responsible stewardship. Leadership expresses sincere hope that this matter will be resolved in the coming months, allowing all involved to move forward in unity and renewed focus on the mission of the Church.
